RESOLUTION NO. 518**

**A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR,  
WASHINGTON, AUTHORIZING APPLICATIONS FOR FUNDING ASSISTANCE  
FOR A WASHINGTON WILDLIFE AND RECREATION PROGRAM PROJECT TO  
THE INTERAGENCY COMMITTEE FOR OUTDOOR RECREATION (IAC) AS  
PROVIDED IN CHAPTER 43.98A RCW.**

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Gig Harbor has approved the 1996 Parks, Recreation and Open Space Plan update to the Parks element of the 1994 Gig Harbor Comprehensive Plan that includes the Harborview Drive Viewpoint; and

WHEREAS, under the provisions of the Washington Wildlife and Recreation Program, state and federal funding assistance has been authorized and made available to aid in financing the cost of land and facilities for local public bodies; and

WHEREAS, the City of Gig Harbor considers it in the best public interest to develop the Harborview Drive Viewpoint;

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, HEREBY RESOLVES AS FOLLOWS:

That the Public Works Director is authorized to make formal application to IAC for funding assistance;

That any fund assistance received will be used for the development of the Harborview Drive Viewpoint;

That the City of Gig Harbor anticipates its share of project funding will be derived from General Revenues;

The City of Gig Harbor acknowledges that any property acquired or facility developed with IAC financial aid must be placed in use as an outdoor recreation facility and be retained in such use in perpetuity unless as otherwise provided and agreed to by the City of Gig Harbor, the IAC, and any affected federal agency;

That this resolution will become part of a formal application to IAC;

That the City of Gig Harbor provided appropriate opportunity for public comment on this application.
