OLD BUSINESS:		
Old Ferry Landing Viewpoint	Commissioner Tarabochia discussed his suggested changes to improve the Harborview Drive Street End Park. They included:  1. Beach resident parking – possibly a vehicle sticker program.  2. Remove picnic tables and install benches.  3. Remove the large planters to provide more open space.  4. Replace fence material to improve the view and discourage vandalism.  5. Increase police presence to reduce problems with vandalism and illegal activities on Friday, Saturday and holiday nights.	Motion: Move to increase police patrols at least on Friday, Saturday and holiday nights to have some sort of schedule or presence in their normal way of doing business.  Tarabochia / Dupuis – unanimously approved.  Public Works staff will take a look at the street and bring back any ideas to improve the parking situation. Staff will provide a right-of-way map and some bench and rail details.
	Parking, striping and sidewalk ideas were discussed with Public Works staff.	
Recycling in Parks	Commission Chair Perrow pointed out the need for recycling in high use City parks like Skansie and Crescent Creek. Different recycling bin options were discussed.	Public Works staff will ask that recycling be incorporated into the new PROS plan update and the Harborview/Judson master plan.

Wilkinson Farm Holly Trees	Public Works Superintendent Malich gave the Commission an update on the plan to remove some holly trees next to the garden area at the park. Parks staff will assess them for age and health and determine outcome of remaining trees.		
	Public Works Director Stubchaer distributed a memo from Lita Dawn Stanton requesting assistance from the Parks Commission to provide a liaison for the Friends of Wilkinson Farm (FWF) group.	Public Works staff will forward information to Commissioners Hampl and Goodwill to see if they have interest in being involved with the FWF.	
	The members present suggested that Commissioner Hampl may be interested in helping with this project.

Kenneth Leo Marvin Veterans Memorial Park – Common Name	Commission Chair Perrow talked about the need to have a more defined name for the park. His suggestion was Veterans Memorial Park.	It was decided to let the common name just evolve with the park.
