ORDINANCE NO. 1292

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO HARASSMENT; AMENDING SECTION 9.26.040 OF THE GIG HARBOR MUNICIPAL CODE TO INCORPORATE PROVISIONS OF STATE LAW REGARDING CYBERSTALKING; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY AND ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted provisions from state law relating to harassment in chapter 9.26 of the Gig Harbor Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the City Council desires to incorporate an additional provision of state law relating to cyberstalking into the Gig Harbor Municipal Code; Now, therefore,

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GIG HARBOR, WASHINGTON, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. <u>Section 9.26.040 - Amended</u>. Section 9.26.040 of the Gig Harbor Municipal Code is amended as follows:

9.26.040 Harassment.

The following state statutes are adopted by reference:

9.61.230 Telephone harassment.

9.61.240 Telephone harassment – Permitting telephone to be used.

9.61.250 Telephone harassment – Offenses, where deemed committed.

9.61.260 Cyberstalking

9A.46.020 Definition - Penalties.

9A.46.030 Place where committed.

9A.46.040 Court-ordered requirements upon person charged with crime – Violation.

9A.46.050 Arraignment – No-contact order.

9A.46.060 Crimes included in harassment.

9A.46.070 Enforcement of orders restricting contact.

9A.46.080 Order restricting contact – Violation.

9A.46.090 Nonliability of peace officer.

9A.46.100 "Convicted," time when.

9A.46.110 Stalking.

<u>Section 2</u>. <u>Severability</u>. If any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance should be held to be unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect the validity or constitutionality of any other section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance.

<u>Section 3</u>. <u>Effective Date</u>. This ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect five days after passage and publication of an approved summary consisting of the title.
